

ORDINANCE NO. 2014-20

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE SIX, CHAPTER TWO, SECTION 1.02(A) OF THE VILLAGE CODE OF THE VILLAGE OF PECATONICA, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the Illinois Municipal Code vests corporate authorities with broad police powers to insure the public health, safety, and peace; and

WHEREAS, the corporate authorities of the Village of Pecatonica have previously determined it is in the best interest to the citizens of the Village and surrounding areas to regulate the height of weeds, grass, greenery, plants, flowers and have adopted an ordinance to that effect entitled, Article Six, "General Offenses", Chapter Two, "Offenses Pertaining to Property", Section 1, "Weeds", which ordinance currently remains in full force and effect; and

WHEREAS, the corporate authorities of the Village of Pecatonica have deemed it in the best interests of the Village to amend said ordinance at this time.

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Pecatonica, Illinois.

Section 1. Article Six, Chapter Two, Section 1.02(A) is hereby amended as follows:

The reference to "Health Officer" shall be revised to read "Building Inspector".

The reference to "seven calendar days" shall be revised to read "forty-eight (48) hours".

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as required by law.
